

Bird Marella Wins Pro Bono Immigration Case for Asylum Seeker

Principal <u>Fanxi Wang</u> secured a pro bono victory in Immigration Court on behalf of her client, an asylum seeker from Guatemala.

Through a partnership with the <u>American Civil Liberties Union (ACLU)</u>, Ms. Wang has represented the client since 2018, after he was improperly incarcerated in a federal prison instead of an immigration detention center by the Trump Administration under its "zero-tolerance" policy. Ms. Wang secured the client's release from detention in 2018.

On December 1, 2022, the Immigration Court granted Ms. Wang's motion to terminate the government's deportation proceedings against the client, allowing the client to remain in the United States with his family and three young U.S. citizen children.
