

Lincenberg, Zipperstein, and Patrick Author Daily Journal Article on California's New Data Privacy Law

In light of the recently passed California ballot proposition on data privacy, principal <u>Gary Lincenberg</u>, senior counsel <u>Steven Zipperstein</u>, and associate <u>Darren Patrick</u> have authored the article, "Here Comes a Wave of Data Privacy Litigation," appearing in the November 9, 2020 edition of the *Daily Journal*.
