

Remembering Dorothy Wolpert



It is with profound sadness that Bird Marella announces the passing of our founding partner and dear friend, Dorothy Wolpert.

Dorothy's reputation for excellence in the courtroom was matched only by her steadfast commitment to public service. Throughout her career, she devoted countless hours to pro bono advocacy, championing the rights of vulnerable individuals and underserved communities, and serving as a leader for organizations dedicated to expanding access to justice, including the Inner City Law Center and the Western Center on Law & Poverty.
